Open Enrollment for 2025 health coverage is here and better than ever. The time to enroll is between November 1, 2024 and January 15, 2025. This year, increased financial help is available to make coverage more affordable – for more people – than ever before.

At CoverME.gov, you can compare plan options, apply for financial assistance, and get help enrolling in a plan that fits your needs and your budget.

## IMMIGRATION STATUS AND COVERME.GOV

- + *Applying will not impact your immigration status, or your family's.*
- + *A consumer does not have to be a U.S. citizen or U.S. national to enroll in a qualified health plan (QHP) through the Marketplace. Immigrants who are lawfully present and meet other basic eligibility requirements may be eligible for coverage through the Marketplace.*
- + *These applicants may also be eligible for financial assistance through the Marketplace, depending on some additional eligibility criteria, including household income and family size.*
- + *Documentation of citizenship or immigration status is only necessary for the people applying for coverage, not for other members of the household.*
- + *Information consumers provide will not be used by government agencies to enforce immigration laws/policies.*
- + *Effective November 1, 2024, Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) recipients are eligible to apply for coverage and may qualify for financial savings.*
